There was a hearing at 6:30 pm on July 9 downstairs in the Community Hall on Application 15-006 from Thomas and Cynthia Mazzaferro for a new seawall at 35 Palmer Road. The hearing was opened by Michael Doyle at 6:35 p.m. Present were Giles Giovinazzi, Lance Loomis, Ken Shailer, WEO Bob McNamara, Scott Eisenlohr, and Mike Doyle; Connie Trolle was unable to attend, and Dr. George Knoecklein was unable to attend. Also present were Thomas and Cynthia Mazzaferro, Dennis McMorrow, Perley Grimes, and others. The hearing was recorded.

Submitted during the hearing (from a previous application, 08-346): a letter dated October 22, 2008 to Ms. Mazzaferro from Robert J. DeSista, Department of the Army; a reduced copy of that site plan by Berkshire Engineering; a reduced copy of property survey by Berkshire Engineering showing the property boundary extending beneath the lake; a page from Department of the Army, Programmatic General Permit, State of Connecticut; a letter dated December 15, 2008 to Mr. Mazzaferro from Dawn McKay, Connecticut DEP; a letter dated December 22, 2008 to Mr. Mazzaferro from Julie Victoria, Connecticut DEP; a letter dated December 22, 2008 to Mr. Mazzaferro from Nancy M. Murray, Connecticut DEP; and a letter dated December 6, 2008 to Mr. Doyle, chairman of the Morris Inland Wetlands Agency, from Sean Hayden, Northwest Conservation District.

It was agreed to continue the hearing to August 6, 2015 at 7:00. The hearing was adjourned at 7:27.

The regular July 9, 2015, meeting was held downstairs in the Community Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were Lance Loomis, Giles Giovinazzi, Ken Shailer, WEO Bob McNamara, Scott Eisenlohr, and Mike Doyle; Connie Trolle was unable to attend. Also present were John Dufour, Dennis McMorrow, and others.

The minutes of the regular June 11, 2015 meeting were accepted as written.
The minutes of the special June 18, 2015 meeting were accepted as written.

New Business

Application 15-005 was received from The Town of Morris for drainage at the playground equipment area at the James Morris School, 10 East Street. The site was visited by Bob McNamara, Scott Eisenlohr, and Mike Doyle on Wednesday. The play area is immediately down-slope of a large area of asphalt that directs rain runoff into the play area. A sketch by Lew Clark shows four mini-catch-basins to collect the water and direct it to a drainage swale. On a motion by Lance Loomis, seconded by Ken Shailer, it was **VOTED** unanimously to approve this application for work in the upland review area that will have no impact on wetlands.

Old Business

Application 15-009 from John Dufour to construct lake walls and to reconfigure the water quality basins was briefly discussed. The site was visited on 6/30. It was agreed to schedule a public hearing on this application for August 6, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. and asking Dr. Knoecklein for input.

Permit 14-500 from Stephen Fenn was briefly discussed. WEO Bob McNamara reported that he spoke with Mr. Fenn to remind him of the meeting. Mr. Fenn again said he was having an engineered design for the driveway. There has been no real progress made by Mr. Fenn since our letter in April requiring that the project be finished in 60 days. On a motion by Lance Loomis, seconded by Ken Shailer, it was **VOTED** unanimously to send a CITATION with a \$250 fine to Mr. Fenn.

Other Business

WEO Bob McNamara's July report was accepted.

The need for a computer was discussed. On a motion by Giles Giovinazzi, seconded by Lance Loomis, it was **VOTED** unanimously to send a letter requesting funds for a computer to the Board of Finance.

There was no other business and the meeting was adjourned at 8:32 p.m.
