

First Selectman's Report September 18, 2018

Anderson Road is complete except for lining at each end. Back filling continues on other roads that had curbing installed. Some washout damage has to be repaired on several roads. Aprons have been installed on driveways and at the Morris Boat Launch.

Attended and participated in meetings with the Northwest Hills Council of Governments, Morris Board of Finance and the Equipment Committee.

Met with our Building Official, Zoning Enforcement Officer, Fiscal Clerk, Highway Department, Treasurer, Activities Director, Assessor, Torrington Area Health District Official, Fire Company Chief and Fire Company President.

Smokey Hollow Bridge Project: Engineering is 90% complete. Some discussion with utility companies and who is responsible for running conduits and trenching for a resident.

Fire House Renovation: Plans are ready for bid once several questions are answered by the State.

JMS Generator- Grant applications are being accepted for the Flood Mitigation Assistance and the Pre-Disaster Mitigation programs. This may be a good opportunity due to generators being listed as a high priority for Morris in the Litchfield Hills Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan. An application will be completed and sent in for the grant.

The First Selectman and the Morris Fire Company have entered into a Fire Protection Agreement and Service Contract. It will be filed with the Town Clerk's Office and will be available on the Town of Morris Website and at the Town Hall.

The First Selectman is now a Certified Connecticut Municipal Official through Connecticut Conference of Municipalities.
