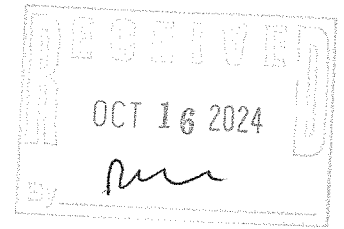


**MORRIS INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION
COMMUNITY HALL
MORRIS, CT 06763**



October, 2024

The regular October 10, 2024 meeting was called to order by the chair at 4:00 pm downstairs in the Community Hall. Present were Connie Trolle, Robin Viola, Doreen Gagnon, and Mike Doyle. Clif Wheeler was unable to attend. Also present were Debi Watson Smiley, AJ Towne, and Ben Paletsky.

The minutes of the regular September 12, 2024 were accepted as written.

On a motion by Connie Trolle, seconded by Robin Viola, it was **VOTED** unanimously to add to the agenda Permit 23-21.

New Business

There was no New Business.

Old Business

Application 24-16 from Debi Watson Smiley to raise and renovate the house and add basement at 227 East Shore Road was considered. AJ Towne explained that the house will be raised enough to excavate under it for a foundation. The material removed will be stockpiled until the project is completed and the excess removed from the site. The walkout basement will be at 901 elevation, with the grade raised to that level for a patio. A drain will be placed above the septic to keep water from that area and route it to the lake. The plan shows the curtain drains and roof leaders also routed to that point to enter the lake. It was remarked that the roof runoff should not directly enter the lake. AJ Towne said that that runoff would be directed to retention, possibly buried. On a motion by Connie Trolle, seconded by Doreen Gagnon, it was **VOTED** unanimously to approve this application with the condition that the roof runoff will be directed to retention.

Other Business

It was agreed that the docks at South Farms have been sufficiently removed from the wetlands. Mr. Paletsky will submit a new application detailing the proposal.

Mike Doyle reported that he had been contacted by the Town that construction debris had been buried at 125 County Road. A Cease Order had been sent to the property owner. Connie Trolle received a text from the owner that he was out of state and would address this when he returned, he said that the 30" pipes on the property are from work he is doing in Woodbury. He said that all activity has ceased on the property. He will submit new plans.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:16 pm.
