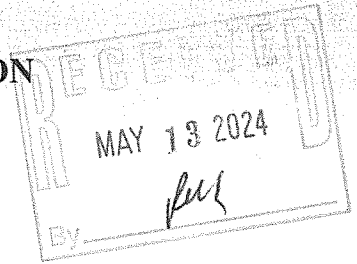


MORRIS INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION

May, 2024

The regular May 9, 2024 meeting was called to order by the chair at 4:05 pm downstairs in the Community Hall. Present were Connie Trolle, Doreen Gagnon, Robin Viola, Clif Wheeler, and Mike Doyle. Also present was Richard Van Nesse.

The minutes of the regular April 11, 2024 meeting were accepted as written.

New Business

Application 24-09 was received from Ian Mac Enterprises to clear a path from the road to the lake at 204 Bantam lake Road. The intent is to place a dock in Nick's cove for commercial purposes. Also placed in the file was a notice dated April 24, 2008 by the Morris P&Z.

Permit 23-13 for Kendra and Ethan Towne to build an addition to the house at 31 Straits Turnpike was modified Originally proposed to build on piers, now to have a full basement on advice from TAHD and the Building Inspector. On a motion by Connie Trolle, seconded by Doreen Gagnon, it was **VOTED** unanimously to approve this modification to the permit, noting that they have a large lot and there should be no impact to the wetlands.

Old Business

Application 24-07 from Dequip LLC as agent for Gerarda Rella to add drainage to the sea wall at 10 Evans Passway was considered. Also submitted was TAHD approval dated 5-1-24. On a motion by Connie Trolle, seconded by Robin Viola, it was **VOTED** unanimously to approve this project to maintain the wall that should have no impact to the lake.

Other Business

Invoice #4241223 was received from Weston & Sampson for the peer review of 34 Woodward Road. On a motion by Connie Trolle, seconded by Clif Wheeler, it was **VOTED** unanimously to authorize payment of \$1,998.62, noting that item 01-6300-690-0 for professional services has \$1000.00; and the wetland senforcement officer item 01-6300-503-1 has funds for the remaining \$998.62.

Invoice 24-05-032k was received from Attorney Byrne for 1.6 hours work on the ordinance. On a motion by Connie Trolle, seconded by Clif Wheeler, it was **VOTED** unanimously to authorize payment of \$320.00

On a motion by Connie Trolle, seconded by Doreen Gagnon, it was **VOTED** unanimously to approve the draft ordinance. It will be sent to the Ordinance Committee and First Selectman Tom Weik.

There was no other business and the meeting was adjourned at 4:17 pm.
