

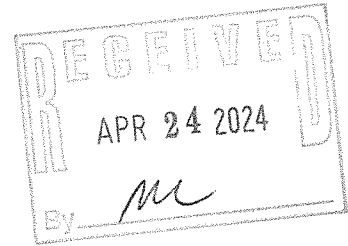
MORRIS SENIOR CENTER COMMISSION
