NON-FEE BASED ITEMS

General Trash - Single Stream Will Include The Following:

Food & Beverage Containers - Cleaned, including laundry detergent and shampoo bottles (less than 3 gallons)

Paper - Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs, Phone Books, Junk Mail, Office Paper, Cereal Boxes

Glass & Metal Food & Beverage Containers - Must be cleaned and rinsed

Plastic #1 through #7 - Must be cleaned and rinsed

Corrugated Cardboard - Folded Flat to 2'x3'

ELECTRONICS - ASK AT SITE FOR INSTRUCTION

Cell Phones, Remove Controls, Pagers, Keyboard/Mouse/Peripherals, Other Small Electronic Devices, Digital Cameras, PDAs, Speakers, Telephones, Two-way Radios, Answering Machines, Camcorders, Light Bulbs-straight, U-shaped, Compact, etc., Non-PCB Ballasts, Tape/VCR/CD & DVD Players, Electric Typewriters, Game Systems, Laptops, Monitors, Desktop Printers, Fax Machines, Pcs, Scanners, TVs, Microwaves

OTHER RECYCLABLE ITEMS:

Motor Oil, Antifreeze, Car Batteries, Oil Filters & Tires, Leaves-Compost-No Bags Please, No Flower Pots of any Type, Brush for Burn Pile-Under 3" diameter, Steel & Metals-Clean, No plastic or wood attached, Mattresses & Box Springs-only clean-Anything stained, torn, bug infested etc, are listed below with Fee Based items.

Empty Aerosol Cans and Empty Latex Paint go into regular household trash.

Aerosol Cans partially full go into the Haz-mat Day.

Latex Paint solid form or liquid, oil paints or stains to our collection site at Transfer Station.

Paints and Stains, with labels on, tops on and no leaks must be on premise 30 minutes prior to closing time.

5 GALLON LIMIT PER DAY

Bi-Annual permits become available April through June.

One Day passes are available.
